### **Removal of many Coronavirus (COVID-19) restrictions in Munich and Bavaria with date from September 2, 2021**

This page is to update you on the removal of many restrictions in Bavaria, Germany

From September 2, 2021, completely new Corona rules and measures apply in Bavaria, Germany, which bring relief, especially for vaccinated and convalescents.

According to the latest rules it is however still mandatory to bring your vaccination certificate and/or a certificate of your convalescent status with you and present it unsolicited at the registration desk when checking in.

#### **How can those who have recovered show their convalescent status?**

1. If the infection was more than 6 months ago\*: Submission of the positive PCR test with date (= time of infection) and submission of the documentation of a vaccination after 6 months: vaccination card ("vaccination pass") or vaccination certificate. Recovered and vaccinated at least once:  
(\*This means that everyone whose illness was more than six months ago must be vaccinated at least once in order to be considered recovered)
2. If the infection occurred within the last 6 months: Submission of a positive PCR test with the date and submission of a negative test after isolation. Or: Notification of the health department to order the isolation and negative test after de-isolation "

#### **What proof do fully vaccinated persons need**

Your vaccination date should be 14 days ago. Corona vaccinations received can be digitally documented at European level. Throughout Germany, you can prove your vaccinations in the Corona app or the CovPass app in a forgery-proof manner. People who have already been fully vaccinated have been able to get their digital vaccination pass from pharmacies since June 14th.
